The dates and times for our

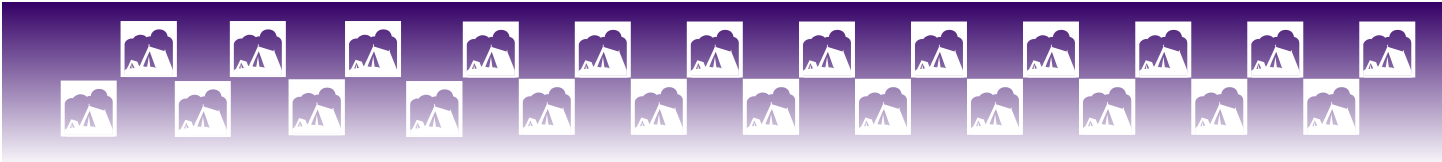
games are in the box below. Please mark these on your calendar. Other times will be announced after we attend training.
